

**ORDINANCE 1790**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING A FISCAL BUDGET FUND; KNOWN AS THE POLICE EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND; FOR THE CITY OF HERINGTON, KANSAS; AUTHORIZING THE GOVERNING BODY TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSFERS OF MONEYS INTO SAID FUND FROM OTHER FISCAL BUDGET RESOURCES; ESTABLISHING AUTHORIZED EXPEDITURES FROM SAID FUND FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF REPLACING POLICE MOTOR VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY OF HERINGTON, KANSAS POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND REPEALING ANY OTHER CURRENT ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

**WHEREAS**, K.S.A. 12-1,117 authorizes the Governing Body of any city, to provide, by adoption of an ordinance, for a Municipal Equipment Reserve Fund to finance the acquisition of equipment; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body desires to establish such a fund expressly for purposes of replacing certain vehicles and equipment utilized for law enforcement purposes, by the Herington Police Department.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Herington, Kansas:

**Section 1.** There is hereby created, for the City of Herington, a special fund, to be known as the Police Equipment Reserve Fund.

**Section 2.** The Governing Body of the City is hereby authorized to levy taxes, and to transfer moneys from other city funds, which may be lawfully utilized for such for purposes, to the Police Equipment Reserve Fund.

**Section 3.** Moneys in the Police Equipment Reserve Fund may be used to finance, in whole or in part, new and replacement equipment. For purposes of this ordinance and Fund, such equipment shall include machinery, vehicles, and other equipment or personal property used for municipal law enforcement purposes.

**Section 4.** Other ordinance or portions thereof in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

**Section 5.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in *The Herington Times*, the official City newspaper.
