ORDINANCE NO. 1802

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HERINGTON, KANSAS, TO REPEAL AND REPLACE CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 6-139 REGULATING BOAT LICENSES AND MANDATORY INSPECTIONS AT THE CITY OWNED LAKE AND RESERVOIR AND REPEALING ANY OTHER CURRENT ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HERINGTON, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That Chapter VI, Article 1, Section 6-139 of the Code of the City of Herington, Kansas, is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety to read as follows:

6-139. BOAT LICENSES AND MANDATORY INSPECTIONS.


No person shall place any craft in the water upon the lake/reservoir without having first had any such craft properly inspected and obtained an inspection tag and license to do so from a duly authorized representative of the City. Such inspection tag and license shall be conspicuously displayed upon the starboard side of the rear end of the craft and, consistent with the terms as outlined in Section 6-141 of this article, shall not be transferable.

SECTION 2. Other ordinance or portions thereof in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
